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Uniform Sign-out Guidelines and Agreement
St Patrick Catholic School

As representatives of St Patrick Catholic School Sports, athletes have a responsibility to handle uniforms in a respectful manner. Upon receipt of the agreement, a uniform will be issued.

1. Athletes agree to keep track of uniform parts during the entire sports season.
2. Uniforms are washed weekly and according to instructions provided by the school and listed on the uniform tag.
3. Athletes will return all uniform parts immediately after completion of the final athletic contest of the season (home or away). All uniform parts will be cleaned and returned to the school office.
4. Athletes/parents agree to the full replacement cost for uniform parts when any of the following situations occur:
 - A. Lost during the season
 - B. Uniform numbers, crest or logos are damaged
 - C. Uniforms have been altered with tape, thread, staples, string or any other materials that affect the fabric in any manner
 - D. Shorts have drawstrings cut, knotted or removed from waistbands
 - E. Tags have been removed
 - F. Marker has been used on clothing surfaces
 - G. Uniform has odors that cannot be removed through laundering.
5. Uniforms will be returned to the St Patrick Catholic School Office. The athletic director will inspect each piece of clothing and contact families in writing in the event that damage, loss, abuse or neglect has occurred.

Signature of this document prior to the start of sport season indicates agreement with these guidelines. Replacement costs for sports apparel will be determined by actual cost to replace the uniforms.

Student Activity Eligibility Policy

All students attending St. Patrick Catholic School are expected to meet a standard of academic effort and achievement, personal conduct and integrity in support of their individual success and the Catholic culture of the school.

Representing St. Patrick Catholic School on a school team or activity is a privilege which places students in a position to be an example and role model to be respected by other students. It is therefore incumbent upon all participants to qualify their academic/conduct eligibility to participate.

To maintain eligibility, the minimum combined academic grade-point status shall be 78.0 in **core subjects** with no grade below 70 in any subject.

Student participants may receive no more than two N's and no U's in conduct in any subject during the eligibility period. Detention notices for non-academic related blatant and willful infractions of school rules will be recorded as an N in conduct and counted in calculating eligibility for the current period.

Scholar athletes determined to be ineligible will be placed on academic probation and may practice but not participate in any game during the probationary period.

Classes for which grades will be submitted by teachers: Religion, Math, Science, Social Studies, English, Literature, Art, Computer, Library (Conduct grade only), Music, Physical Education, and Spanish. **Core classes include: religion, math, science, social studies, literature, and language arts.**

Point values for computation of core GPA are those found in the student Handbook under **Grading Scale**.

Initial fall eligibility will be based upon end-of-year final grades from the previous year. Continuing eligibility will be based upon grades after the first three weeks of the current school year, at interim term (six weeks) and at end-of-term dates (12 weeks) throughout the season of participation.

Students determined to be on probation as of the regular periodic qualifications dates (fall 3, all 6, 12 weeks) will have the opportunity to re-qualify each week until eligibility status has been achieved.

Students determined to be on probation due to low conduct grades will be responsible to carry eligibility reports to each teacher, each week on Friday or the final day of school for the week until eligibility has been re-established.

Students must be in attendance at school for the **full day** to participate at practice, games, or in activity on that day.

Consequences for egregious misconduct will be determined by the principal according to school general conduct policy.
